I attended the Thursday evening Melbourne forum and have a minor point to clarify re wording of suggestions for Proposal 6.

We suggested a reporting system along the lines of that of the Adverse Drug Reactions Advisory Committee (ADRAC), part of TGA. Medicos or the general public can report unexpected or adverse drug reactions by completing a reply paid form which is available from the committee. (It was on the web but for the life of me I can't find it – another example of web invisibility.)

If I remember correctly, the wording of the proposal omitted 'national' as part of the concept. The wording should also include the notion of anyone being able to report a suspected effect of a chemical, not just OHS professionals, medicos etc.

I found the forum valuable.
