Further to comments I made in an earlier email, I would also like to highlight three specific areas of need when it comes to the management of MCS:

1. Pregnant women need safe places where they can receive ante and post natal treatment in addition to delivery. A chemically sensitive acquaintance of mine was forced to have her baby at home under the care of a midwife because she reacts to hospital disinfectants
2. Children with MCS need to know that they will be safe in the school environment and also in medical facilities
3. The elderly – patients suffering from dementia and other disabling conditions of aging cannot currently access safe aged care accommodation because of the risk of reaction to chemicals used in these places.
